JOB DESCRIPTION LITTER PICKER

Litter Picker – Job Description

Part-time role, normally 4 hours per week. Regular working hours will include 2 hours on Saturday (am) and 2 hours on Sunday (am) with the possibility of other hours to accommodate the needs of the service.

The role will be subject to a completion of a satisfactory probationary period of 3 months. The role will be paid at the living wage rate.

A driving license is not essential, but the appointed person may be required to work at various locations within the town.

The ability to work on own initiative without supervision is essential

Job Purpose

To keep Wem Recreation Ground tidy and free from litter and assist the Town Council's Groundsman with any other tasks that may be required.

Main Duties

1. To carry out a regular litter collection of Wem Recreation Ground on a Saturday and Sunday before Midday.
2. To empty litter bins on the recreation ground
3. To store all litter collected in the groundsman's compound (or other specified location) for collection.
4. To report any graffiti, vandalism or dog fouling to the Groundsman.
5. To carry out any other tasks that may be required by the Groundsman.
