<u>RESOLVED</u>:- that the Town Council welcomes the redevelopment of this site and the suggested design however the Council does have specific objections to the plans as outlined below;

Layout and Density of the proposed building -

- The proposed height of the property is too large for the site and will have too dominant an impact on the street scene of New Street.
- There are inadequate number of car parking spaces proposed for development.

Parking, Highway Safety and traffic

- There is insufficient of pedestrian access around the proposed building as
 the main access to the proposed development off New Street is an
 important pedestrian link to town via Drawwell walk and Wem Business
 Park. A condition of any planning permission should include the creation of
 a pavement from New Street along the entire adjacent to the entire site to
 provide safe pedestrian access to Drawwell Walk and Wem Business Park.
- The Council would wish to see that the Highway Access to this site is upgraded as part of the development

v) 20/04003/TCA Address: 1 High Street, Wem, SY4 5AA, Proposal: Remove 1No. Spruce tree within Wem Conservation Area
