A member of the public raised the following items

Roden Grove Development – Work has already started on this site and residents are all very concerned that damage is being caused to the site in advance of the archaeological survey. Cllr Nash responded that he and Cllr Mellings are in discussions with Shropshire Council regarding this matter.

Planning application 17/01924/FUL – the proposed development is not in keeping with the area and the applicant has not addressed any of the concerns raised.

Honorary Townsman Boards – In his opinion these boards should be on display in the Town Hall as the award is a community award and should be on display for all to see.

Mill Street Wall – Can the Town Council find out how this wall is to be rebuilt and how the traffic is going to be managed during the rebuild.

Mr Edwards reported that after 18 years of attending Town Council meetings this was the last one he intended to attend. He was thanked by the Mayor and all Councillors for his keen interest and input into Town Council meetings over the last 18 years.

A member of the public objected to planning application 17/01924/FUL and stated that Wem does not have the facilities to provide for the needs of those who may live in a home of this nature. In addition to this the application is contrary to the Town Design Statement and will have a negative impact on biodiversity.
