 The Council consider that the proposed pedestrian access between New Street and Wem Business Park is still unsatisfactory. As part of any planning permission the applicant should be required to construct a surfaced pavement wide enough for wheelchairs to provide a safe pedestrian access between New Street and Wem Business Park. What is currently proposed at the corner of New Street and The Business Park access is insufficient in width.

The Town Council would wish to see that any Section 106 contributions. arising from this development are allocated for public open spaces instead of affordable housing.
