Dear all, the government via the Department for Transport (DFT) is undertaking a national consultation on pavement parking <https://www.gov.uk/government/consultations/managing-pavement-parking/pavement-parking-options-for-change> presenting possible solutions for consideration, of which all are demonstrated in the link and supportive material contained. I'm aware that as a local authority we have numerous concerns and complaints raised with us from residents, town and parish councils and Shropshire Council Members direct, with regard to pavement parking, which can be either deemed as obstructive, dangerous, inconsiderate or perhaps necessary.
