Market Town Clerks meeting 30.1.18

Eddie West from Shropshire Council provided an update on the Local Plan Review which had drawn over 650 responses. Early indications from the responses are mixed with protectionist groups unhappy with the high growth proposals and agents and developers requesting more growth! Concern has also been raised over the methodology used to allocate community hubs. He reported that the site allocations consultation had been set back and would probably now begin in August 2018 with a view to submit the final plan in January 2019. The change in the deadline would provide officers with more time to talk to communities and it was anticipated that a meeting will be held with all councils where land is to be allocated for development. A discussion took place on the changes to the community infrastructure levy that were currently being considered and it was reported that the scrutiny committee were currently looking at the proposals to alter the policy of how CIL is spent and what it is being spent on, it is anticipated an update on this would be available by late February.

An update was also received on the Kear Highways contract which will start on 1st April – currently discussions are underway in relation to the impact that the £5 million reduction in the highways budget will have on the contract however it was anticipate that these issues would be concluded prior to the start of the contract. Concern was expressed over the proposed removal of funding for Environmental Maintenance Grant in the 2018-19 especially after a significant amount of work was carried out by the working party to look at ways in which the grant could be more effective.

Clerk attended Audit and year end preparation on 8.2.18 and viewed External Audit changes webinar 12.2.18.
