Message: I would like to speak to someone about the possibility of having a children's play area made a no ball game zone. The play area is on Oakley Meadow and consists of a fenced play area which contains a climbing frame and slide suitable for young children and toddlers. The enclosed area also has 2 benches and a refuse bin. The area has recently been used by older children and some adults as a football area and this is totally unsuitable. The footballs have been thumped against the play equipment, benches and fence and often, due to the power behind the kick, the ball has ended up in peoples front gardens or under parked cars. The noise of the constant thumping of the ball against the play equipment is also a nuisance as it echoes off the adjacent houses. My concern is that the play equipment or benches will be damaged rendering them either unusable or potentially dangerous and of course there will be a cost involved if repairs are needed. The play area is smaller than the one off Guttery Close which I note has signs stating no ball games. Thank you in advance of your response.
