a) Manager - Karen gave an update on the usage of the building. She explained that numbers are down post lockdown but usage is improving and they are hopeful that they may return to pre covid levels in the next few months, there are currently 149 direct debit members and 82 annual members so there is a steady income from membership. Swimming lessons are very strong with a big waiting list which is a result of covid and other local pools closing. She reported that they are short staffed but lifeguard training is taking place.

### b) WSLC Board Report

Mike presented the board report and explained that work is planned to repair the fan and lifted tiles on pool base. There is still a small leak in the pool and this is probably a consequence of the pipe repair work which will be investigated.

An issue going into the winter could be the rising oil prices and this is being monitored.

The board is currently focused on keeping open and reducing losses so any long-term development plans are currently on hold.

### c) Financial Report

It was reported that the centre's financial accounts are starting to look more promising and a very small surplus was recorded for the first time in months.
