She explained that the committee only required the Town Council to pay for the upgrading of the electrical lines. Frustration was expressed that the Town Council had not been notified of this matter sooner especially as a working party had been established on 24.11.22 which had spent considerable time and effort producing the report to be considered.

<u>Resolved</u>: - that the proposed Christmas lights budget amount be agreed for the purposes of the 2023-24 budget. But that the final implementation of a new or revised lighting scheme be deferred to allow for further discussions with the Christmas Lights and Festival Committee with a final decision to be made by the end of March 2023.
