There is concern for highway safety at this point as this is an already dangerous section of highway for road users and pedestrians alike. ii) **23/03054/FUL** Stables Day Care Nursery, 20 Wemsbrook Road, Wem, Shropshire

Proposal: Conversion of an outbuilding formerly used as a Childrens Nursery to facilitate a change of use into 4 holiday flats.

Proposal: Erection of a temporary modular building on the site of the previous Wem Sports & Social Club which was demolished in 2021 to act as a clubhouse for Wem Town FC and the local community
