## Lighting

Councillors were made aware of reduced maintenance charges following the LED conversion.

Resolved:-to approve the recommendation of the Amenities and Services Committee that the Public Lighting Budget be set at £26,000

# Cemetery

It was reported that this budget included provision to replace the cemetery fence.

Resolved:-to approve the recommendation of the Amenities and Services Committee that the Burial Ground Budget be set at £7,590 including the contribution to Whitchurch Road Cemetery.

#### **Allotments**

The Clerk outlined the need to increase the budget slightly to cover increases in water charges.

Resolved:- to approve the recommendation of the Amenities and Services Committee that the Allotments Budget be set at £1,000

### Administration

The Clerk outlined that the recommendation of the Finance and Corporate Governance Committee was to keep the administration budget at the same level.

<u>Resolved</u>:-to approve the recommendation of the Finance and Corporate Governance Committee that the Administration Budget is set at £24,480.

#### Contributions

Other than the contributions agreed under item 147a/20 a discussion took place on the need to allocate funds for Wem Economic Forum and for the awarding of small grants.

Resolved:- to approve the contributions budget of £14,400 with £5000 being allocated for grant awards and £1000 allocated for Wem Economic Forum.

### Recreation

It was explained that the play equipment budget required increasing in order to put funds aside for new items of play equipment including replacement skate ramps.

Resolved:-to approve the recommendation of the Amenities and Services Committee that the recreation budget is set at £32,600.

## **Swimming Pool**

In addition to the contribution agreed for Wem Swimming and Lifestyle Centre under item 147a/20 it was reported that the budget for insurance and repairs be maintained at 2019/20 levels.

Resolved:-to approve the swimming pool budget of £64,300.

### **Staffing**

<u>Resolved</u>:- to approve the recommendation of the Finance and Corporate Governance Committee that the Staffing budget is set at £108,404.

## **CIIr Expenses**

<u>Resolved</u>:-. to approve the recommendation of the Finance and Corporate Governance Committee that the Cllr Expenses budget is maintained at £1,075.
