### **Road Closures**

**Road to be closed: Station Road and Aston Road, Wem, Start Date: 18 September 2017**

Duration: 47 days (24 hours) Purpose: Gas Mains Replacement, Applicant: Wales and West Utilities  
A one way system will operate over the level crossing access will only be for traffic travelling from West to East. Vehicles wishing to enter the town from the Saulton Road side of the crossing will have to follow a diversion for 3 weeks. A one way system will also be in operation in Station Road and traffic will not be able to exit station Station Road via Aston Street. A meeting was held with Adrian Degg of Wales and West Utilities on 9.8.17 to discuss the road closure. The Town Clerk agreed to help with promotion of the road closure. Adrian Degg was informed of the importance of informing the public of the closure especially the the schools and coach companies. Concerns were also raised around local diversion routes as Church Lane was considered not suitable for any form of diversion.
