# Covid-19 Response Update Winter – Spring 2021

Since our first 'Public Notice' leaflet sent out nearly a year ago, Wem Town Council has continued to actively monitor all that has been happening with regard to the Covid-19 pandemic and how this impacts locally and this is our fourth leaflet updating our advice to you. It is particularly important that it reaches those who have no computer/email facility and is why we are using the Royal Mail to distribute the leaflet to reach as many homes as possible.

Our NHS is under increasing pressure particularly with this new and faster spreading variant. Vaccinations have begun but this will take some time to reach everybody. Wem & Prees and Clive Medical Practices will get in touch with you when you are eligible for the vaccine. Please be patient and do not contact the surgery as they are still maintaining normal day to day services. There is no charge for this vaccine so please do not respond to scam emails or calls, you will be contacted only by your surgery when you are eligible for the vaccine.

Please note that vaccination arrangements may be subject to change at very short notice, please take the advice of your GP in the first instance, they will advise you of any change.

Please continue to check on your neighbours in a safe way, find out their phone/contact detail(s) for easier communication, and make sure they have food, essential items and whether they need help in some way. Anxiety, loneliness, poverty and work-related issues are the experience of so many during the last few months. Please find ways to support people safely and find out whether any extra help is needed.

The new projects and services implemented after the last lockdown will continue and more details can be found in the body of this leaflet.

We urge you to continue to follow Government Guidance in the hope that some restrictions can be lifted in the coming months. This leaflet has been produced to provide residents with updated information during lockdown. ### Covid -19 Vaccination Information

Wem and Press Medical Practice are currently inviting patients over 80 to have their vaccine for COVID19. The vaccine has been safely delivered to the Robert Jones and Agnes Hunt Hospital in Oswestry and patients will need to travel there for their vaccine. The vaccine is the Pfizer vaccine and once delivered cannot be safely moved hence why patients must travel there.

**Clive Medical Practice** are inviting patients eligible for the vaccine to attend the Shropshire Education Centre at the Royal Shrewsbury Hospital.

Please note that vaccination arrangements may be subject to change at very short notice, please take the advice of your GP in the first instance.

# COVID Test and Trace Support Payments

If you're on a low income you may be entitled to a test and trace support payment of £500 if you: Have been told to stay at home and self-isolate by the NHS Test and Trace service, either because you've tested positive for coronavirus or have recently been in close contact with someone who has tested positive, and 1. Are employed or self-employed, 2. Are unable to work from home and will lose income as a result, and 3. Are currently receiving universal credit, working tax credit, income-based employment and support allowance, income-based jobseeker's allowance, income support, housing benefit and/or pension credit.

### Local Food and Financial Support

#### **Wem Food Share**

Leftover food which is still good to eat but would otherwise go to waste is collected regularly by volunteers from local supermarkets. It is usually shared with partner groups and organisations across the town but due to the pandemic this service is open to everyone.

We need your help to get this good food eaten. We never know what food we're going to get. There will usually be fruit, veg and sometimes eggs. Some days we have lots, some days less, but everyone is welcome to come and have a share. The food shares are run on a pay what you can afford basis. No worries if you don't donate – you're helping by getting the food eaten. Food shares are usually held fortnightly on a Saturday morning 10-12 at Wem Scout Hut SY4 5AP (opposite Wem Swimming Pool). Details of the next food share can be found by telephoning 01939 232 733 or checking Wem Town Council's or other community facebook pages.

Please do not come if you or a household member have Covid symptoms or have had a positive test. Everyone is required to wear a face covering (unless exempt) and we ask you to sanitise your hands when you arrive. Many of the food shares take place outside (under gazebos) but if indoors, numbers will be limited. There are markers so everyone can queue 2m apart.

#### Wem Meals on Wheels

Following the success of the 3 month pilot scheme, the Wem Meals on Wheels service will be continuing into 2021. The service provides a hot mid-day meal & pudding for £5.50 per person per delivery (special diets cannot be catered for at this time except vegetarian). These are freshly cooked by local businesses, delivered to your door twice weekly on Monday & Friday by local volunteers. The scheme is open to residents of Wem town only at present.
